



2009 Access Grant guidelines now available

Letters of Inquiry from prospective grantees in the Connecting Consumers with Care, Strengthening the Voice for Access; and The Innovation Fund for the Uninsured program areas are due September 1, 2009

JULY 2, 2009 — Since December 2001, the Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts (BCBSMA) Foundation has made grant awards to help expand access to care for the uninsured and low-income residents of Massachusetts. These grants have been made in three program focus areas that we collectively refer to as the Foundation's "Access Grants": ***Innovation Fund for the Uninsured, Connecting Consumers with Care, and Strengthening the Voice for Access.*** The Foundation will make a limited number of new grants in these areas this December.

After reviewing the LOIs, we will invite a select number of applicants to submit full proposals.
- **Invited Proposals and Proposals from current grantees seeking renewal due October 16, 2009 by 5:00 p.m.**
